



Gregory Baum is Professor Emeritus at McGill University's Faculty of Religious Studies. His academic education was in Catholic theology and sociology; his publications dealt with ecumenical relations, interreligious dialogue, and the religious quest for a just and peaceful world. During the Vatican Council (1962-1965), he was an appointed theologian at the Ecumenical Secretariat responsible for the conciliar documents on Ecumenism, Religious Liberty and the Church's Relationship to Non-Christian Religions.
